

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

This timetable shows the full service from London Paddington to Greenford. For the full service between London Paddington, Ealing Broadway, West Ealing and local stations to Reading and Heathrow Airport, please see timetable 8.

All stations in this timetable are in the Transport for London 'Oyster Pay as You Go' area and the Oyster fare zones are indicated next to the stations in the timetable. Interchange with London Underground services is provided at Greenford (Central Line), Ealing Broadway (District and Central Lines) and at London Paddington (Bakerloo, Circle, Hammersmith & City and District Lines). Please note there are no First Great Western Sunday services at Acton Main Line, West Ealing, Drayton Green, Castle Bar Park, South Greenford or Greenford stations.
