This timetable shows the complete train service between Leeds and Knaresborough and between Leeds and York via Harrogate. Other trains also run between Leeds and York via other routes.

Through trains and connections

At the side of the station name **a** means arrival time and **d** means departure time. If the train times are in **bold type** you won't have to change trains.

If your arrival time is shown in light type, change at the previous station whose time is printed in bold type unless a footnote gives other instructions.

If your departure time is shown in light type, change at the next station whose time is printed in bold type unless a footnote gives other instructions.



Buying your ticket

It's a legal requirement to have a valid ticket or pass before you start your journey and you risk prosecution if you travel without one.

You must buy your ticket from the ticket office or ticket vending machine **before** getting on the train. If the ticket office is closed or you board at an unstaffed station you can buy your ticket from the conductor on the train. If you avoid using the ticket office or vending machine when they're available, the conductor will charge you the full Anytime Single/Return fare. Alternatively buy your ticket online at northernrail.org #getaticket.

Bus pick-up points

Burley Park – on Ashville Road – next to the station entrance for Harrogate, and the opposite side of the road for Leeds.

Cattal – the entrance to the Victoria pub car park, next to level crossing.

Hammerton – the entrance to the station car park, next to the level crossing.

Harrogate – in the station car park.

Headingley – the bus stops on Kirkstall Lane, near the junction with the station approach road – on the same side of the road for Leeds, and the opposite side for Harrogate.

Hornbeam Park – on Hookstone Road by the entrance to the public park – in the layby for Harrogate, opposite the layby for Leeds.

Horsforth – the bus stop on Station Road opposite the hairdresser called Sallys Salon.

Knaresborough – the bus stops near the traffic lights at the road junction on High Street – same side of the road as the station for Harrogate, the opposite side for York.

Leeds – the bus stops Stands A and B, on New Station Street by City House.

Pannal – on the main road at the bus stops outside the BMW Garage – the same side of the road for Harrogate, and opposite for Leeds.

Poppleton – at the bus stops next to the level crossing – same side of the road as the station for York, and opposite for Harrogate.

Starbeck – at the bus stops next to the level crossing – the same side of the road as the station for York, and opposite for Harrogate.

Weeton – at the bus stops on Harrogate Road next to the junction with the station approach road – on the same side of the road as the station for Leeds, and opposite for Harrogate.

York – at bus stand E outside the Royal York Hotel
