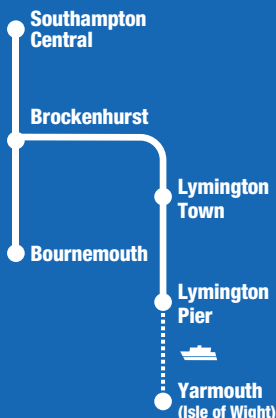

What's happening?

From 5 to 28 August inclusive, major engineering works will be taking place at London Waterloo. This is to allow work to start to extend platforms for longer trains and provide more space for more passengers.

Throughout this time, fewer trains will be running across the South West Trains network. Some stations will see very significant reductions in the frequency of their train services and a small number will be closed for some or all of this time.

Stations in or around London, such as London Waterloo, Clapham Junction, Vauxhall and Wimbledon are expected to be exceptionally busy during this time. We strongly advise passengers to avoid travelling during the busiest morning and evening periods if possible.

Woking is expected to be extremely busy and you are advised not to change on to fast services here.

Across the network, we urge passengers to leave plenty of time for their journey, plan ahead and understand the impact these temporary changes will have.

August Bank Holiday

Friday 25 August to Monday 28 August 2017

On Friday 25 August to Monday 28 August 2017, there will be additional works at London Waterloo.

This will further reduce the number of trains we are able to run right across the network but the impact will be more significant closer to London.

Temporary timetable Monday to Friday only 7-24 August 2017

This timetable shows services between Brockenhurst, Lymington Town and Lymington Pier with connecting services to and from London Waterloo and Bournemouth. Please see pocket timetable 28 for full details of services between Brockenhurst and stations to Southampton Central and London Waterloo, also stations to Bournemouth, Poole and Weymouth.

Services on this route have not been revised.

Please check if you are connecting into other services during this time.

Buy a ticket before you board

You need to buy a valid ticket before you board one of our trains. We know that the vast majority of our passengers buy a valid ticket before travelling and we have a duty to those passengers to make sure no one travels without paying. For this reason, we run a penalty fares scheme across most of our network.

If you travel to or from a station within the penalty fares area without a valid ticket, you may be liable for a penalty fare of £20 or twice the single fare to the next station at which your train stops (whichever is higher). You will then be required to buy a ticket for the remainder of the journey.

We have a policy to prosecute all deliberate fare evaders, wherever possible.

Cycles on trains

The services in this timetable have limited room for cycles and we have to apply some restrictions. The ★ symbol, with train times printed in red, show restricted trains. These restrictions are explained in the 'Notes' section.

We will carry folding cycles on any train as long as they can be folded small enough to be carried safely in the luggage rack. Cycles are not allowed on buses that replace trains during engineering work.

No smoking policy

For the comfort of all our customers, smoking and the use of e-cigarettes is not permitted on any part of our trains or stations. You can smoke outside the station entrance or in our car parks.

Passengers travelling with cycles may not join or leave services timed to arrive in London Waterloo between 0715 and 1000 inclusive and departing London Waterloo between 1645 and 1900.
